Application: in the form of application letter specifying

- the field of study (plus the specialization if a study field has more specialisations);
- three areas for admission examination:

in the programme Biochemistry:
 biochemistry (compulsory)
 molecular biology and genetics (compulsory)
 one of the following three areas:
 biology of plants, biology of animals, biology of microorganisms

all remaining programmes – three areas from:
 zoology, botany, ecology, physiology of plants and animals, cell biology and genetics, biological chemistry, biomedical laboratory techniques.

Deadline for application: May 15, of the current academic year for the admission to the next academic year.

Admission examination and interview: late June, applicants will be notified about the details in a letter from the vice-dean for bachelor and master studies.

Dean's decision on admission: within 5 days after the examination and interview.

Enrollment of the accepted applicants: early September (according to an individual arrangement granted by the Dean).

* The programme in cooperation with the Johannes Kepler Universität in Linz, realised partly in Č. Budějovice partly in Linz, Austria.

Fees:

Study in Czech language: free of charge.

Study in English: the annual composite fee (covering tuition, examinations, assessment, graduation) - 3 000 Euro. (Does not apply to the study programme Biochemistry, study field Biological chemistry – tuition is only in English, free of charge on the Czech part, a fee of approx. 200 Euro on the Austrian part.
