Application – Admission Procedure to Master Study Programme **Biological Chemistry**

This updated version is valid as of 1. 5. 2020.

Study programme – Master	Study field
Biochemistry	Biological chemistry (studies in English only)

The programme takes 2.5 year, it is realized in a cooperation with the Johannes Kepler Universität in Linz, Austria, students in the programme study for the first year in Linz, the second year in České Budějovice, and the third year a year partly in Linz, partly in České Budějovice.

Application: in the form of application and motivation letter* , an officially certified recognition of Bachelor diploma (in Czech language) with Diploma supplement (list of finished courses with the grades) in English or Czech.

Deadline for application: **May 15**, of the current academic year for the admission to the next academic year.

Applicants pre-evaluation: Commission will evaluate individual applications in relation to the level of chemistry and biology knowledge of the applicants based on the list of the passed courses during the bachelor studies. Applicants with unsatisfactory coverage of chemistry and/or biology subjects in their previous bachelor studies will not be accepted and advised to apply for the bachelor programme Biological Chemistry.

Applicants with satisfactory list of chemistry and biology courses will be either accepted immediately or invited to an admission examination and interview.

Admission examination and interview*: late August, examination of

1. Biochemistry,
2. Molecular and Cell Biology,
3. General, Organic, and Analytical Chemistry.
4. English Language – the examination aims at evaluating the student's ability to study in the English language, the required level is B2. The examination consists of listening (understanding a short lecture in English), writing (production of a text on a given topic), and reading (understanding a secondary school level text and showing the candidate's ability to present the content of the text).

The examination is evaluated on a scale of 1 – 6 points; receiving 3 – 6 points means “Passed”, whereas receiving 1 – 2 points means “Failed”.

Applicants will be notified about the details (date and place) by letter/e-mail from the vice-dean for bachelor and master studies. Skype interview is possible.

Dean's decision on admission: within 5 days after the examination and interview.

Enrolment of the accepted applicants: early September (according to an individual arrangement granted by the Dean).
