

## Measure of the Dean D 90 on financial support for cross-border degree programmes

Students who study the first year of their study programme at a foreign partner university, at which the study programme is accredited, are entitled to financial support in the form of an exceptional scholarship.

This financial support is to be provided on a discretional basis and is not guaranteed to each student. The amount of financial support in the given academic year is to be set by the Dean of the Faculty.

Financial support is to be provided only to those students of the study programme who have been accepted to study at the Faculty of Science of the University of South Bohemia.

It is not necessary to apply for this support (the Department of Student Affairs is to prepare the supporting documents).

Financial support is to be granted to students in the months of September to January. A double amount to cover initial expenses is to be granted in the September of the first year of Bachelor's study.

In order to receive financial support for the months of February to May (for the 1st year of a Bachelor's degree) and February to June (for the 1st year of a Master's degree), students are to submit, in the second half of February, a document from their foreign partner university to the Department of Student Affairs of the Faculty of Science. This document confirms that they have gained a total number of at least 20 credits for the modules studied in the first semester of study. If they do not submit this evidence by the set deadline, the payment of the financial support is to be terminated.

If a student attends a foreign partner university again in the 3rd year of their Bachelor's degree, their financial support, to the amount set by the Dean, is to be



paid for the period stipulated as the shortest necessary length of stay at the partner university (in the case of the Biological Chemistry program, the period from September to March.)

In the 1st year of a Master's degree, the financial support, to the amount set by the Dean, is to be granted for the period from September to January. In order to receive financial support for the period from February to May, the same condition applies as in the first year of Bachelor's study (see above).
